

# PASTOR'S MESSAGE



WE TRUST IN DIVINE PROVIDENCE AND REMAIN JOYFUL IN HOPE. I KNOW THAT I AM BLESSED TO BE THE PASTOR OF THIS PARISH.





The apostle St. Paul wrote of the Divine Virtues of Faith, Hope and Love in his first letter to the Corinthians (see 1 Cor. 13:13). Christ is the reason for our hope as He was victorious. Through the cross of Calvary, Christ paid the debt for human sin and reconciled us to the Father. Through His resurrection, He opened for us the path to eternal life. I believe that Christians are inherently hopeful, because we believe in the promise of eternal life. In other words, our struggles and challenges in this life are temporary. Every weekend, I meet someone who is new to the parish.

I sincerely thank all of our parishioners who supported the parish in gracious stewardship in the past year. In recent months, many have made donations online, through the mail or in the Sunday offertory. At the end of the fiscal year, on June 30, our offertory had recovered significantly. I realize that some of our parishioners may still be struggling after losing some earnings, investments or opportunities. The parish is not a business, but we have to plan and track a budget every year and to strive for efficiency. All of our staff leaders realize that we need to be good stewards of the gracious charity of our parishioners. Throughout the crisis, we supported local charities through our poor box revenues and tithing account. Through numerous Second Collections, we have supported ministries and programs throughout the Church.

I appreciate every donation and family involvement. If any person or family is able to make an extra donation to assist us at this time, it will be greatly appreciated! We trust in Divine Providence and remain joyful in hope. I know that I am blessed to be the pastor of this parish.

# **FINANCIAL STATUS**

### **REVENUES**

**Revenues** rose from \$2,371,000 in the prior year to \$2,511,000 in 2021-22 (a 5.9% increase).

The prior year's revenues were heavily impacted by the Coronavirus shutdown.

This year saw things bouncing back in the second half of the year.

By far the largest source of revenue in 2021-22 (77%) was \$1,929,000 from offertory collections.

Other key sources of revenue included:

- \$82,000 from Religious Formation fees/donations
- \$151,000 from Pre-school/Day-care fees
- \$42,000 from Diocesan Support Appeal Rebate
- \$73,000 from house rentals
- \$80,000 from general donations
- \$86,000 from donations for Capital facilities

### **EXPENSES**

2021-2022 Expenses totaled \$1,940,000. Just under half (49%) of our expenses supported wages and benefits of \$810,000 for staff and \$140,000 for clergy.

Of the remaining (51%) expenditures, notable line items include:

- \$354,000 Facilities and Utilities
- \$142,000 General and Administrative
- \$247,000 Diocesan Assessments (some of these assessments include General Administration, Catholic News & Herald, Software Fees, and other minor miscellaneous assessments and dues).
- \$71.000 Catholic School Assessment

In addition, \$375,000 was spent on replacing the roofing on the Parish Life Center.

Due to financial concerns regarding recent and historic challenges, our parish provided meticulous budgetary oversight that resulted in a 10% reduction from expected expenses. In real terms, of the \$2,132,000 expected costs, we spent only \$1,940,000 which gave us a difference of \$192,000.



As of the end of June 2022, the Parish had cash on hand of \$673,000; \$432,000 in savings; and monies earmarked for Building Maintenance and Debt Reduction of \$199,000. There was a total of \$481,000 in restricted cash and endowments.

# CHARITY



From a Charity perspective, two fund raising events were held for **FeedNC** (formerly known as the Soup Kitchen) and the **Mooresville Area Christian Mission (MACM)**, in June and August, respectively.

Thanks to our parishioners and a few non-parishioners, the total impact of our fundraising efforts was \$733,000 (in cash/pledges and in-kind). In addition, two families from our Parish have made a pledge of \$200,000 outside of our campaign. Together, our Parish and the 75th Anniversary Celebrations have had a total impact of \$933,000 in our local community.





In addition, 7,500 lbs. of new clothing (valued at \$150,000) were donated to the **MACM**. Piggy backing off this donation, through efforts of our Parish's Community Ministries, the "Clothesline" project generated funds that are included in the above totals.

As a result of our fundraising efforts, the following naming rights have been secured:

- 1. The Food Pantry in the new **FeedNC** complex being built is to be called "St. Therese Food Pantry."
- 2. The Picnic and Shelter Area also in the new **FeedNC** complex will be called "St. Therese Picnic Area."

(The above rights are for 25 years, however, given the support from the Parish, we have requested the rights be in perpetuity.)

- 3. The "Teaching Kitchen" will be named after a parish family.
- 4. The Kitchen at **MACM**'s new building will be called "The St. Therese Kitchen" in perpetuity.

#### **Rise Against Hunger program:**

We are proud to be associated with the **Rise Against Hunger program**. On October 2, 2022, parishioners Nora and Larry Paffrath spearheaded the effort for our parish to host the event in which 244 volunteers packed almost 36,000 meals in 2.5 hours. The meals were used in feeding programs in Ethiopia.





# DIOCESAN SUPPORT APPEAL (DSA) REBATE & NEW PRESCHOOL TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM:

Through the generous contributions of our Parishioners, we exceeded the goal set by the Diocese for the 2021 DSA. The excess funds of approximately \$42,000 were returned to our parish as a rebate.

The rebate has been set aside to provide children of our parish who attend our Little Way Preschool, and those of whom may have qualifying financial needs, to receive tuition assistance. For the upcoming school year, \$10,000 is being set aside to kick-off this program.




